### HIGHLIGHTS

- ◆ Tuition is collected in **ten payments** from **August to May** on the **20<sup>th</sup>** of the month.
- ◆ Payment made in full by August 31st will receive a one-time family **discount of \$75**.
- ◆ Tuition Payment should be made by a monthly debit from your bank account to eliminate paper statements and late fees.
- ◆ The multiple child family tuition rates **do not apply** to the Early Childhood Program.
- ◆ The registration fee is \$100 for one child, \$125 for two children, and \$150 for three or more children for Pre-School to Grade 8.
- ◆ Tuition can be reduced through participation in **Store Scrip** (Giant, ShopRite, and Kohl's), **Market Day**, and **Genuardi's E-Scrip**
- ◆ Since fundraisers and tuition do not cover the \$5,450 projected cost of educating a student for the 2011-12 school year, a **minimum offering of \$10 in the Sunday envelope** is expected to help defray the projected 37% parish subsidy.
